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THE DOM-CHROMATIC INDEX OF A GRAPH

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Abstract

An edge set $F \subseteq E(G)$ is a dom-edge coloring set of a graph G = (V, E), if F satisfy the conditions such as every edge not in F is adjacent to some edge in F and every edge color class E_i contains atleast one edge $e_i \in F$, $1 \leq i \leq m$. The dom-chromatic index $\chi_{ed}(G)$ is the minimum cardinality taken overall dom-edge coloring sets of a graph G. In this paper, we initiate a study on $\chi_{ed}(G)$ and its exact values for some standard graphs have been established. Also its relationship with other graph theoretic parameters are investigated.

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
